#### Reception GLD:

- The percentage of children achieving GLD is 66%. **This an 11% increase on 2022** and inline with National 2022.
- Prime areas – all broadly in with previous cohort %.
- Biggest increase in % - **77% Word Reading** (66% last year) and **74% Writing** (63% last year).

#### Phonics Check:

- Y1 - 73% of children passed phonics check, **which is broadly in line with previous cohort and national 2022**. LW phonics/Daily Catch up 9 children did not pass the phonics check.
- Y2 - **80% of children passed phonics check**, of those who did not pass in Y2. 2 children did not pass. Y2 children remained in phonics group and received Daily Catch up. 2 children did not pass. 1 x child – new to school this year/EAL

#### Year 2 SATs

##### Context – 21% PP/9% SEND

- 62% met ARE in Reading, which is in line with previous cohort but below national 2022
- **65% met ARE in Writing, which is above previous cohort and above national 2022**
- 56% met ARE in Maths, which is in line with previous cohort but below national 2022

#### Year 4 MTC

##### Context – 24% PP/17% SEND

- 30% of children scored 25/25, which is a **7% increase on previous cohort**
- 72% of children scored 20+, which is an **8% increase on previous cohort**
- The **average score of the MTC is 21, compared with 18 from previous cohort**

#### Year 6

##### Context – 34% PP/18% SEND

##### Writing

- **68% met ARE in Writing, which is in line with national 2022 and 14% more than previous cohort**
- 8% achieved GD in Writing, which is **8% more than previous cohort** but below national 2023
- 2 children moved from EXS at KS1 to GD at KS2
- 4 children moved from WTS at KS1 to EXS at KS2
- 1 child moved from PK at KS1 to WTS at KS2
- 90% of children made expected progress e.g WTS-WTS or EXS-EXS
- 94% of PP children made expected progress
