As Writers...

We will be revising grammar features and spelling rules from the previous year. Children will organise their writing into paragraphs or sections depending on the genre. This half term we will cover: predicting, storytelling, letter and diary writing, instructions, non-chronological reports and balanced arguments.

Key Vocabulary: noun, verb, adjective, adverb, co-ordinating conjunctions (BOYS), commas to list, statement, command, question, expanded noun phrase, contraction

This is an overview of what your child will be learning this half term.

The Romans



As Mathematicians...

We will be exploring place value up to 10,000 including placing on a number line, estimating numbers, comparing and ordering and flexible partitioning. We will also be finding 1,10,100,1000 more or less than a given number, rounding to 10,100 and 1000 and working with Roman numerals to 100.

We will also start to look at written methods for addition and subtraction.

Key Vocabulary: partition, flexible partition, estimate, greater than, less than, intervals, multiple

As Scientists...

We will be studying forces and magnets. The children will explore this using a range of short experiments and longer investigations.

Key Vocabulary: push, pull, force, friction, attract, repel, investigate, fair test

In Geography

We will be finding out about earthquakes looking at where they occur and why.

Key Vocabulary: Richter scale, plates, magnitude, devastation, impact, infrastructure, economy, damage, repair

In Computing...

We will be exploring Logo.

We will be learning to create mathematical shapes using given commands. We will also use the repeat function as well as considering angles and degrees for turns.

Key Vocabulary: direction, command, turn, straight, turtle, repeat, degree

As Artists

We will be exploring collage this half term.

We will explore, experiment and evaluate silhouette, materials and collage materials. We will look at how some artists have used collage to express themselves.

Key Vocabulary: silhouette, shadow, materials, layer, overlap, express, interpret

In PSHE...

We will be looking at Me and My Relationships.

Key Vocabulary: positive healthy relationship, collaborate, teamwork, feelings, problems, solutions

As French speakers...

We will be exploring vowels, vocabulary linked to describing the classroom, Haiti and ourselves.

Key Vocabulary: Essential verb: to be, – ÊTRE

I am – **je suis** , you are – **tu es**, he is – **il est**
she is – **elle est**, it is, it's – **c'est**

In PE...

We will be revising fundamental skills of balance, running, dodging, hopping, jumping and skipping.

Key Vocabulary: respect, collaborate, determination, support and encourage others.

As Musicians...

We will looking at Mamma Mia and the music of Abba. The children will sing, listen and appraise, play musical games and begin to recognise elements of music.

Key Vocabulary: tempo, texture, dynamics, pitch, dynamics, pulse, rhythm.
