The Romans



As Mathematicians...

We shall continue to practise the written methods for addition and subtraction and consolidate use their knowledge of number bonds and place value. We shall also work together to unpick word problems linked to written methods. Following this, we shall look at multiplication and division, making links between the two and understanding they are inverse (opposite) calculations.

Key vocabulary: multiply, divide, inverse, multiple, divisible by, lots of, groups of, number bond, sum, total, factor, product

As Scientists...

- We will be exploring Animals including humans. We will identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.
- We will identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.

Key Vocabulary: Nutrition, nutrients, carbohydrates, sugars, protein, vitamins, minerals, fibre, fat, water, skeleton, bones, muscles, support, protect, skull, ribs, spine, muscles, joints.

In History...

We will be finding out why the Romans came to Britain and the impact their invasion and settlement had on our way of life.

Key Vocabulary: invade, settle, develop, protect, fort, trade, Celt, artefacts

In Computing...

We are exploring spreadsheets. We will create line graphs and bar charts. We will enter formulae using a wizard.

Key Vocabulary: cell, row, column, formulae,

As Designers

We will be exploring textiles and sewing.

We will design, evaluate and join textiles using a range of stitches and decorative items.

Key Vocabulary: join, stitch, running stitch, cross stitch, embellish, hessian, pouch, drawstring

In PSHE...

We will be looking at Valuing Difference.

This is the half-term where we also deliver our Protective Behaviour Programme. This is key to children knowing how to keep themselves safe.

Key Vocabulary: safe, unsafe, secrets, rights, responsibilities, network

As French speakers...

We will talk about our homes and what we have using the vocabulary:

I have – *j'ai*, you have – *tu as*, he has – *il a*

she has – *elle a*

it is *a* – *C'est un/une*...

In PE...

We will be practising some gymnastic and ball skills.

Key Vocabulary: balance, control, counter balance, hold, partner, core, collaborate

As Musicians...

We will be developing our glockenspiel skills. We will learn to play different pieces of music developing our understanding of rhythm. We will also become more familiar with standard notation.

Key Vocabulary: tempo, texture, dynamics, pitch, dynamics, pulse, rhythm. notation
