As Mathematicians...

Y5

We will be learning about multiplication and division and fractions.

Key vocabulary: multiply, divide, multiple, factor, convert, common denominator, integer, unit fraction, non-unit fraction, compare, order, solve.

As Scientists...

We will be learning about material and their properties.

Key Vocabulary: solid, liquid, gas, material, soluble, insoluble, conductor, filtering, evaporation, condensation, reversible.

As Historians...

We will be learning about the Shang Dynasty and how a pile of dragon bones help to solve an ancient Chinese mystery.

Key Vocabulary: mythical, dynasty, hieroglyphs, interpret, inscription, historian, ancient, engraved, society, jade, domestic, barter, class, immortality
